- Staff attendance struggling with family and personal illnesses

■ Effective School Framework

- 4th Grade Reading and Math scores- areas Griffith students struggles in
 - Students do not score as well in 4th grade as they do in 3rd grade
 - o Enrichment activities offered to build skills to improve scores
 - Targeted Improvement Plan (School Improvement Plan 2019-2020)
 - Improved classroom instruction
 - Auditing lesson plans with curriculum coordinators
 - Essential Learning Outcomes- what students must know to pass to the next grade level
 - Check tests scores to provide support to students in need
 - PLC Tuesdays- to provide collaboration between teachers
 - Increase student motivation for reading

■ Campus Improvement Plan
