



LJI 1ST DAY PROCEDURES : PHASE ONE F2F

STUDENTS AND PARENTS

You also need to know what those first 8 days on campus will look like.

LJI Arrival - 7:00-7:15a - You will enter through the main front entrance and report to the cafeteria where tables will be marked by grade and for social distancing. Be sure your mask is on once you are on campus grounds.

What You Need - Prepare like you would for a usual school day. In your backpack, bring all your school supplies, Chromebook with charger, earbuds/headphones, clear water bottle, and lunch (if you choose). Breakfast and Lunch will be provided to students. ** Be sure that your Chromebook is fully charged the night before.

Students Eating breakfast (even if you bring your own) report to the top portion of the cafeteria nearest the serving lines and be seated. You will then be dismissed by table (2 per table) to get breakfast. The teachers on duty will monitor the food lines and release tables to maintain social distancing in line. You must ask permission to throw trash away and then move to an open seat in the grade level area.

Students NOT eating breakfast will sit in their grade designated areas following all safety procedures (social distancing and mask). Teachers on duty will monitor and ensure these safety procedures are followed. Once you are seated in one of these areas you will need an adult's permission to move from that seat.

Between 7:15a-7:25a, Dr. Tsang and the Admin team will briefly talk through procedures and expectations for phase one (including 1st or 2nd lunch).

You will then be grouped based on your 5th period class due to the two lunch periods during 5th period. These two groups will spread out in the cafeteria (the largest area with the best ventilation and air flow) and monitored by certified teachers and instructional aides.



You will follow your schedule virtually while in the cafeteria. Students will attend F2F (Face to Face) PE class during their PE/Athletics period. All social distancing guidelines will be followed during the transition to PE and while in class.

Dismissal-

Students who walk or ride their bikes will be escorted out of the building on the 7th grade side by an adult to maintain social distancing.

Students who are being picked up will be escorted out of the building through the main entrance by an adult to maintain social distancing.

Students who need to wait for their ride can remain in the cafeteria. These students will be monitored until 4:30.
