Frequently Asked Questions

- **How do I know what to do on August 19th, the first day of school?**
 - Teachers have added students to each of their Google classrooms. Students will need to accept each teacher's invite to his/her specific Google classroom.
 - If you have any issues logging into your Chromebook or accessing Google Classroom, please follow the [directions linked here](#) or contact the **BISD Helpdesk at 979-730-7450 before the start of school.**

- **How do I know when to log on and what to do?**
 - Teachers will be sending online materials and assignments and scheduling virtual Google Meets (*video conferencing for all students during their class period*) in Google Classroom. It is imperative that you follow the steps above to access the materials. The LJI bell schedules with their lunches are listed below. Students will take lunch based on their 5th period teacher.

- **What if I am unable to attend class at the scheduled time?**
 - You are expected to be actively engaged in learning for a minimum of six to seven hours daily. This means you will need to be logged in and actively participating in instructional activities. Attendance will be taken at the beginning of each class period for all content areas (ELA, math, science, social studies). You will follow the schedule and times listed. For PE, music, art, band, and other electives, lessons will either be live streamed or lessons will be recorded with assignments and assigned in Google Classroom.
- **What if I need to ask my teacher a question outside of virtual class time?**
 - You may email your teacher questions, and the teacher will respond by the following day during their conference period, or you may ask the questions the next day during your class period.
- **What if my teacher isn't in the Google Meet at the scheduled start time?**
 - If you are joining a meeting from Google Classroom, wait for your teacher to join and then click the button labeled "reload".

Tips for Success

- ★ Establish a daily routine and stick with it. Make sure that your student gets a good night's rest.
- ★ Provide a breakfast BEFORE the learning begins. (curbside meal pick-up is available at campus from 12-1p everyday)
- ★ Have general supplies available before the school day begins. (paper, pens, pencils...)
- ★ Inform other family members that the block of time set aside for learning needs to be uninterrupted and quiet.
- ★ Provide frequent breaks as needed, but disable your sound and video during the break.
- ★ Students should reflect on the lesson after each class meeting.
- ★ Students should ask clarifying questions before the class meeting ends so that the assignment and task instructions are clear.
- ★ Please be aware the Student Code of Conduct may be applied during virtual learning.
