In a previous letter, we shared with you the information about the Texas Education Agency's decision that requires all students, including virtual students to test in-person on campus.

Wednesday, February 10th, all 7th grade students will take a practice Writing STAAR test.

Please know that we respect your decision and reasons for remaining virtual. While we practice social distancing guidelines laid out by the CDC, we have planned additional safeguards for your virtual student on these testing days. This includes:

- Staggered Start and Stop times
- Dedicated point of entry
- Smaller testing groups
- Minimal Interactions

Plan to drop your virtual student off using the front main entrance off of Oyster Creek Drive. There will be signs indicating drop off and entry point. Your virtual student will enter the building through door number 30. This entrance will take them directly to their testing room.

Logistics of the Day:

- Arrival between 8:00 am and 8:20 am (no later than 8:20 am)
- Test will begin promptly at 8:30 am
- Student pick up is between 12:45 pm–1:00 pm

What your student needs:

- Face Mask
- Charged Chromebook (with charger just in case)
- Two #2 pencils
- Bottled Water
- Snacks (that does not leave residue on fingers or have nuts in the ingredients)
 - Crackers (Wheat Thins, Goldfish, Animal)
 - Dried fruit, Granola bar, Nilla Wafers
 - Dry cereal
