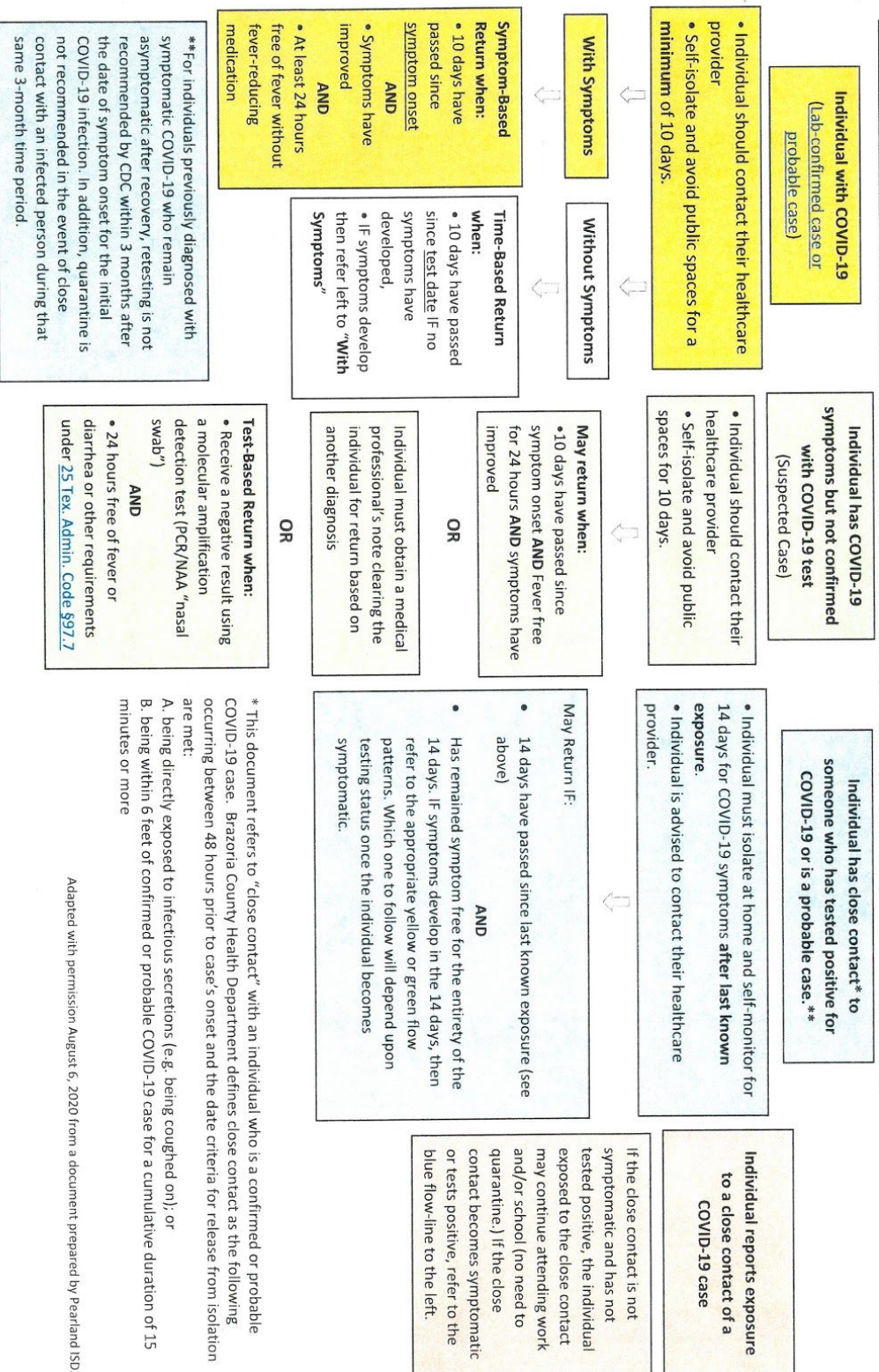


# COVID-19 FLOWCHART FOR STAFF & STUDENTS

**COVID-19 Symptoms:** FEELING FEVERISH OR MEASURED TEMP ≥ 100.0°F, LOSS OF TASTE OR SMELL, COUGH, DIFFICULTY BREATHING, SHORTNESS OF BREATH, FATIGUE, HEADACHE, CHILLS, SORE THROAT, CONGESTION OR RUNNY NOSE, SHAKING OR EXAGGERATED SHIVERING, SIGNIFICANT MUSCLE PAIN OR ACHES, DIARRHEA, NAUSEA OR VOMITING



\* This document refers to "close contact" with an individual who is a confirmed or probable COVID-19 case. Brazoria County Health Department defines close contact as the following occurring between 48 hours prior to case's onset and the date criteria for release from isolation are met:  
A. being directly exposed to infectious secretions (e.g. being coughed on); or  
B. being within 6 feet of confirmed or probable COVID-19 case for a cumulative duration of 15 minutes or more
